



LARGEST RUBE GOLDBERG

The following act as a guide to the specific considerations and undertakings, in addition to the general requirements as detailed in the General Rules of the Record Breakers' Pack, for any potential attempt on the above record.

They should be read and understood by all concerned – organisers, participants and witnesses – prior to the event.

Please note that, as detailed in the Agreement Regarding Record Attempts, these guidelines in no way provide any kind of safety advice or can be construed as providing any comfort that the record is free from risk.

GUIDELINES

These rules are for the largest functional Rube Goldberg machine constructed.

- 1 - The machine must complete an everyday task in the most complicated way possible in the tradition of Rube Goldberg designs. This task must be clearly defined prior to the attempt.
- 2 - All steps must be labelled clearly and listed according to when and where they occur.
- 3 - The function of each step must also be clearly defined.
- 4 - The machine must complete a full cycle. A full cycle includes a first run to the completion of the task, a complete reset and a second run to completion of the task.
- 5 - There must be no human intervention once the machine is in progress. Any intervention will result in the attempt being invalidated.
- 6 - A machine may not incorporate a live animal.
- 7 - A machine may not display any corporate sponsor logos.
- 8 - A machine may not imply profane, indecent or lewd expressions.
- 9 - Any loose or flying objects must remain within the set boundaries of the machine.
