### Chemistry Division

The chemistry laboratory is a hazardous place. Safety precautions are necessary when working with chemicals, glass, hot liquids and instruments. It is important that the following laboratory rules be observed at all times.

1. Never work in the lab without supervision.
2. Keep lab bench clear of books, backpack and clothing (except your lab manual)
3. Never bring food or drinks into the lab.
4. Do not lick any labels off your tongue.
5. No children, spouses or any unauthorized persons are allowed to enter the lab with you at any time.
6. Never apply cosmetics of any kind while in the lab.
7. Never handle flammable materials near an open flame.
8. Open toed shoes are not allowed in the lab.
9. Tie back long hair when working in the lab especially around open flames.
10. Turn off Bunsen Burners when not in use.
11. Dispose off any sharp objects such as broken glass into proper disposal containers.
12. Notify your instructor if there are any spills, breakage, cuts, burns or other injuries.
13. Familiarize yourself with the location of the fire extinguishers, fire blanket, emergency shower, eye wash, and first aid kit.
14. Treat all equipment with respect and care.
15. Put back all equipment in its proper place.
16. Never remove specimens, cultures or equipment from the lab.
17. Make sure your work area is neat and clean when you exit from the lab.
18. Wash your hands before leaving the lab.
